Day 1: 22nd September 2021

Coff's Harbour to Toowoomba Today's travel takes us into Brisbane whilst passing through Surfers Paradise Lunch today in Brisbane City Mall (Own Expense) Whilst coach can pick up Melbourne Passenger from Brisbane Airport. This Afternoons travel will take us through Gatton and Ipswich before arriving in Toowoomba for the next 4 nights

Full day Local Touring (Warwick) Today's travel takes us to WARWICK Qld Warwick is a thriving and attractive town which can claim to be the first important settlement in inland Queensland. We see the Warwick Railway Station in Lyons Street which was built from local sandstone in the 1880's We also visit Glengallan which is not just any old house. Uninhabited for more than half its lifetime, it remains frozen in time and is one of the few remaining examples of a substantial 19th Century country house in Queensland. (Overnight Toowoomba)

Day 4: 25th September 2021

Toowoomba (Local Sights) Today we make our way to JONDARYAN WOOLSHED. BUILT IN 1859 IT IS THE OLDEST OPERATING woolshed in Australia and the first purpose-built shearing shed in the country. We will enjoy a guided tour see sheep shearing demonstration, working sheep dogs and steam farm machinery in operation. A camp oven lunch is also included. This afternoon, back in Toowoomba, we visit the Cobb & Co Museum. It is more comprehensive than its name suggests. It traces the history of horse drawn transportation in Australia. (Overnight Toowoomba)

Toowoomba, we spend the day exploring more of Toowoomba including a visit to Laurel Bank Park. Its fragrant blooms and floral displays are magnificent. We also visit Queens Park and the Botanical Gardens which reflect the grand gardening designs of a particularly English nature and is home to stately old trees, many of which are more than 100 years old. (Overnight Toowoomba)

Day 6: 27th September 2021

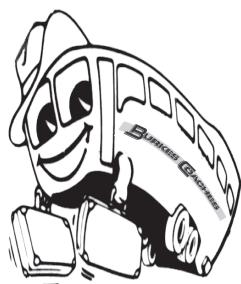
